Policies and Guidelines for Photography at the Lady Bird Johnson Wildflower Center

This facility is a wonderful representation of the many uses of native plants in both landscaped gardens and natural areas. The policies and guidelines below are designed to complement the ecological mission of the Lady Bird Johnson Wildflower Center - a non-profit organization committed to educating people about the environmental necessity, economic value, and natural beauty of native plants.

REGISTER AND APPLY WITH THE WILDFLOWER CENTER

- All professional/commercial/wedding photographers wishing to shoot at the Wildflower Center are required to register with the Center through the Facility Rental Manager.
- Wedding clients of the Center receive a complimentary 2 hour photo session but must be scheduled in advance of the session as normal to ensure there is not a conflict in reservation time.
- All applications and fees must be filed, paid for and approved before the photo shoot may be scheduled.

General Photography Guidelines

1. Please be courteous and polite to the general public and visitors. Do not block paths or restrict access to the grounds. No public area may be closed to visitor access during a photo shoot.
2. You and your clients must stay on the paths. Please do not leave the path or public areas to step into the gardens. Fire ants, poison ivy and snakes are probable in this natural environment.
3. With the exception of service animals, no dogs or pets are allowed in the Center.
4. No smoking or tobacco use is permitted on the grounds at any time.
5. Use utmost care and caution around all landscaping.
6. Digging or planting of any plant material on the grounds is strictly prohibited. Absolutely no cutting of any plant material is permitted.
7. Plant tags or signs are not to be moved or removed for any reason.
8. Under no circumstances will nudity be permitted on the grounds of the Center. You and your guests must be properly attired at all times while on site.
9. Alcoholic beverages are not permitted on the grounds and if observed will result in immediate cancellation of the shoot without refund of fees.
10. Props or equipment belonging to the Wildflower Center may not be used in photo shoots.
11. Per University of Texas at Austin regulations, drones are not permitted on the grounds at any time.
